SAYS JOB IS HIS FOR LIFE

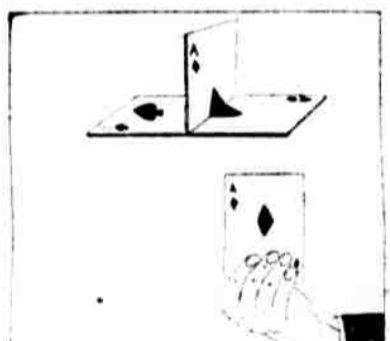

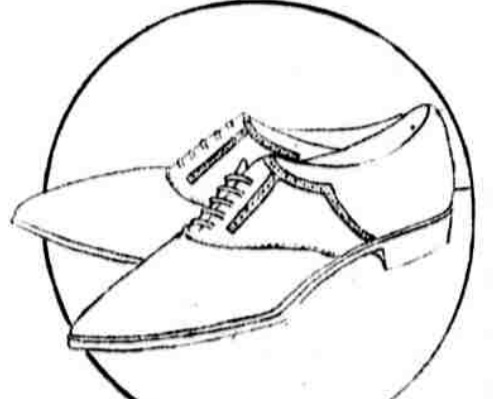
