REVENUES Total revenues for the year 1921 (partly estimated), including the gross income from government-owned monopolies and industries, amounted to \$267,000,000.

RESOURCES AND COMMERCE The islands, which include Java, Sumatra and Celebes, have an estimated population of about 50,000,000, possess great natural resources and constitute one of the richest of all colonial possessions.

GOVERNMENT-OWNED PROPERTY AND DEBT Total funded debt, exclusive of this loan and the Bonds recently issued, approximates \$212,000,000. The Government controls great natural resources of value difficult to estimate and owns revenue producing properties, including over 2,500 miles of tramways and railroads.

CURRENCY AND EXCHANGE The unit of currency is the guilder, or florin, with parity of 40.2 cents. Its present quotation of approximately 37.6 cents represents a discount of less than seven per cent.
