TORONTO CHOIR WONDERFUL ORGANIZATION OF SINGERS

Mendelssohn Choir Unquestionably One of the Greatest in the World

What was in many respects the most wonderful exposition of choral singing that this city has ever heard, was given in the Academy of Music last evening by the famous Mendelssohn Choir, of Toronto, an organization which, in its first Philadelphia appearance, fully justified all the encomiums that have been heaped upon it.

The choir is composed of about 250 voices, perfectly balanced, with an unusually large percentage of the voices among them, and with a character of tone amazingly fresh and youthful. It was of vast power when demanded, but the finest of all the effects were the voices could scarcely be heard in the rear of the Academy, but, nevertheless, perfectly balanced and full of color and warmth.

Each composition showed different requirements and in each of them the choir met with the full measure of success. It has everything that a chorus can have: perfect ensemble, balance, under absolute control, immense power and equal delivery, and both without any loss of tonal quality or color; impeccable enunciation, unity in the nuances, perfect attack and release, colorful tone of exquisite quality and enthusiasm for their work.

John Barclay was the soloist and he sang splendidly in Vaughan Williams somewhat disappointing "Sea Symphony" for baritone solo, chorus and orchestra, and even better in the symphonic "Wreck of the Julie Plante." His voice is of fine quality and resonance, and the three contrasted numbers he carried out finely the ideas of the composers.

Too much cannot be said of Mr. Fricker, the conductor. A choir is always what its conductor makes it.

His return to the city is usually the measure of his abilities. It is true that he has fine material here, but this also is due to him, and what he has accomplished with it is even more wonderful. Mr. Fricker's choir is a truly stand as one of the world's greatest choral conductors and trainers, just as his organization takes the same position among the singing organizations of the world.
