LEGION WANTS ALL DISABLED HELPED Drive to See Every Man Hurt in War Is Properly Taken Care Of Is Started

BIG CAMPAIGN PLANNED A clean-up campaign for the rehabilitation of the disabled soldier is about to be undertaken by the American Legion of Pennsylvania.
