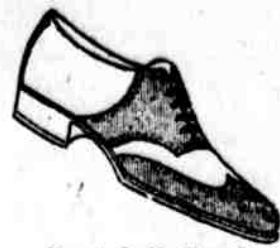
O want that be wonderfull, thank you ever so much, I think youre much more ambitious than Benny, sed Mary Watkins.

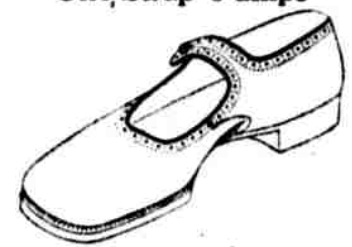
