U. S. REPLY NO FINAL, VIEW OF LLOYD GEORGE

Believes Note Rejecting Hague Plan Basis for Further Negotiations
DOOR TO RUSSIAN PARLEY NOT SLAMMED, IS BELIEF
Allies Surprised at American Action—Russia Also May Balk
GENOA MEETING NEAR END
Washington Looks for Modified Proposals—Conference at State Department

Genoa, May 16.—(By A. P.)—The American refusal to participate in the commission to sit at The Hague on Russian affairs is her final word, as the document indicates great American interest in Russia's economic reconstruction, and the reply is regarded as one forming a basis for further correspondence.

The surprise caused by the declaration was accentuated by reason of a statement by the American ambassador in London, Mr. Lloyd George, shortly after noon.

Great disappointment at the American answer was expressed in conference circles, as the belief was prevalent that the United States was ready now to join the other powers in dealing with Russian economic problems.

London, May 16.—(By A. P.)—Referred by the United States to participate in the proposed conference at Genoa, the British and Daily Mail, both of which are the organs of the Foreign Office, expressed their surprise at the failure of the conference here to achieve definite results.

The statement by Mr. Bakosky, of the State Department, that the Russian will go to The Hague is regarded as a slight toward the American position, and it is expected that the American will be asked to participate in the conference.
