THE cup cake, the slice cakes, and I similar cakes are made in a slightly different manner from the cakes given in the preceding lessons.

The cup cakes are usually baked in the various sizes of the muffin pans, starting with the tiny bouche to the regular sized muffin pan that is usually two and one-half to three inches across the top.

Before starting to mix the cake batter, take the pans and be sure they are clean and smooth inside, rub liberally with good shortening and then dust with flour. Turn pans upside down, and tap against the table to remove excess flour, place in cool place until ready for use. Individual Wine Cakes

One and one-half cups of flour, Two teaspoons of baking powder. Sift the flour and baking powder four times before adding to the mixture in the bowl.

One-half oup of cold water. Beat this mixture to smooth batter for about five minutes, then cut and fold in the stiffly beaten whites of the three eggs. Turn in an ablong or square pan, and bake twenty minutes in hot To prepare the pan, grease and

Fancy Sheet Mixture for Making Special Cut Cakes Place in mixing bowl

One and one-quarter cups of sugar, Bis tablespoons of butter, Yolks of four eggs.
Cream until light and fluffy, now add Two and three-quarters cups of four, Three teaspoons of baking powder.

Sift the flour and baking powder four times before adding to the mixture in the bowl

Three-quarters cup of milk. Now beat the cake mixture until it is smooth, and like cream, then cut and fold in the stiffly beaten whites of the four eggs, and turn in a well-greased and floured baking pan, having the batter about one inch deep. Bake in hot oven for eighteen minutes. When cake is cold, cut in either oblongs or squares, and cover with icing. For variety the squares may be split in two or three, and a filling of either jelly. eggs, and turn in a well




