On a gently rolling plateau overlookbeautiful resort known as Deal, or Deal Beach, a collection of handsome homes and hotels, where many of the coun-try's well-to-do spend the summer.

One can hardly find the boundary line between Deal and Allenburst, so closely do the many beautiful homes and hotels in each approach each other along the many drives leading from the

shore boulevard.

Separating Allenhurst and Asbury Park, with its western arms penetrating a benutiful wooded tract, lies the largest of the fresh-water lakes in this section, its eastern end only a few hundred feet from the breakers. This is Deal Lake, lying so close to the shore line with the section. line and the surf that only a few yards separate the two, and extending for considerable distance into the back country amid beautiful park-like de-velopments. A number of pretty islets dot its placid surface, making it ideal for picnicking and canoeing.

Famous Asbury Park Asbury Park, which has been called

the place "where the sea and country meet," lies just south of Allenhurst, with Deal Lake for its northern boundary and Wesley Lake, a smaller body of fresh water, separating it from Ocean Grove. Somewhat over a mile in length from its northern boundary to the southern limits, it extends back from the ocean considerable distance into the country. Its streets and avenues, only a few hundred feet from the breaker line, have been cut from the charming farm and timber land which marks this portion of the coast—in many places century-old trees line its wide boulevards, forming a verdure-green frame for the emerald

Asbury Park's Boardwalk is eighty leet in width and extends the entire length of the city, connects with the Boardwalk which fronts Ocean Grove. and making a continuous promenade o more than two miles in length. It commands an unobstructed vista of the sea from all points except where three short plers extend into the breakers. The Boardwalk is brilliantly illuminated at night throughout its entire length. night throughout its

Fishing and Crabbing

Fishing and crabbing may be indulged in during the whole summer. Bathing hours at Asbury Park during the busy summer season is a sight well worth seeing. Thousands throng the beach in varicolored and vari-patterned bathing suits. The huge beach umbrella, striped or spotted with all the colors of the rainbow, dots the beach like a field of exaggerated mushrooms, and bathing dress and summer tollets intermingle almost at the water's edge. Canoes, boats and launches are avail-

able at boat liveries on Deal, Sunset and Wesley Lakes. There are public tennis grounds at two places in the city and good baseball games during the season. The golfer may use the course of the Deal Country Club on payment of the usual greens fees. Several theatres, presenting the newest attractions and motion platters, appeal for tions and motio pictures, appeal to many, while there are the usual amuse-

many, while there are the usual ansusement features of the seashore resort scattered along the Boardwalk.

The automobile roads in Monmouth County are many and exceptionally fine. Public sight-seeing autos leave Asbury Park twice daily during the season for a trip through Lakewood and over the Rumson road.

Ocean Grove, separated from Asbury Park by the narrow and shallow Wesley Lake, but joined at the beach end and

Lake, but joined at the beach end and west of the lake to the latter resort. is notable not only as a senshore resort of prominence, but as the greatest camp-meeting point in the world, and shares with Asbury Park the admiration of thousands of visitors.

Along Shark River Shark River, rising back in the little blils among the pines, spreads out into broad and shallow bay just back of the shore line below Bradley Beach, and pours its waters into the Atlantic through a narrow inlet.






