

VAUCLAIN TO SOUND PROSPERITY TOCSIN

Head of Baldwin's Starts Tour of Country to Combat "Gloom Spreaders"

HAS OPTIMISTIC MESSAGE

Business and "prosperity talk" will be the chief aim of the pilgrimage of Samuel M. Vauclain throughout the United States starting today. With his official staff, the president of the Baldwin Locomotive Works will leave West Philadelphia Station on a special train to touch at all the principal industrial cities of the country. The Vauclain optimism, which has become known in many parts of the world and vindicated by his own success in finding business when others have declared there was none, will be disseminated on the journey. During a thirty-day trip Mr. Vauclain will visit St. Louis, Kansas City, Topeka, Albuquerque, San Bernardino, Los Angeles, San Francisco, Portland,

Seattle, Vancouver, Winnipeg, St. Paul and Chicago. "I will try in my address to have people look upon our present prosperity in a favorable light," he said. "Any one who has been abroad cannot help seeing the well off we are. Any one who goes to Atlantic City or who walks up and down Chestnut street or Broad street cannot help see it, too. The city is not paralyzed. "General business is good," he added. "Some few lines are not so well off as they might be—the locomotive business, for instance. We cannot expect to have our full prosperity until the other lines of business recognize prosperity and start to act upon it. Then, of course, they will need more locomotives. "We have everything to be thankful for in this country."
