"Ma" Cooper Says More Intoxicated Girls Are Brought Into Central Station Than in Old-Time "Wet" Days

Silver-haired, and with eyes that shine with kindness and sympathy, Mrs. Margaret Cooper, for twenty-five years the matron at Central Station, City Hall, is known to all around the hall as "Ma" Cooper.

Hundreds, yes, even thousands, of girls and women have poured forth their troubles to her, and despite her long years of service, "Ma" Cooper has not become "hardened," and she has a fresh interest for each girl who is sent to her.

"I do not have nearly so many girls sent to me now as I once did," she says. "From 225 to 250 a month the number has gone down to less than a hundred. The majority of my cases now are larceny, particularly shoplifting."

Girls want to print and look pretty—because men like pretty-dressed girls—and with not enough money to buy the things they want, they will take to shoplifting.

"The hardest thing I have to do is to take children away from their mothers. Last week I had a woman with a little boy and girl, and, oh, how she did cling to them! No matter how slow and out a woman may be, she almost always has the true mother love for her children."
