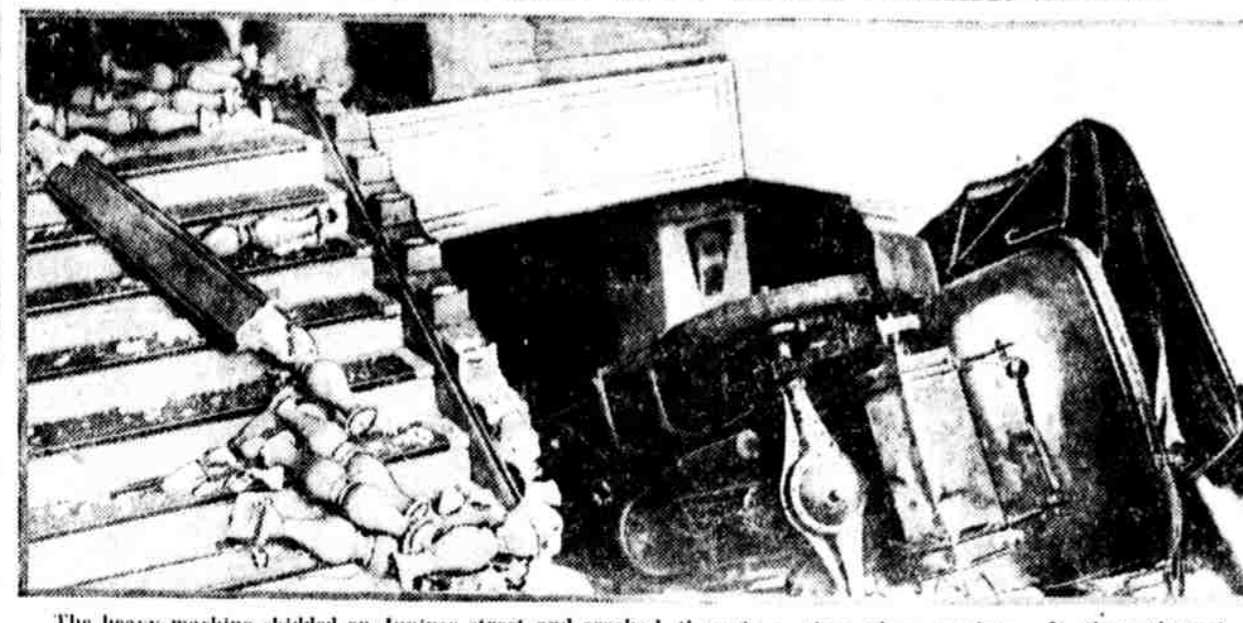


**AUTO WHICH PLUNGED INTO WANAMAKER STORE**
