by the continuity writer, or the director, or, yes, even the actors themselves, not to mention subtitle writers and the cutting room.

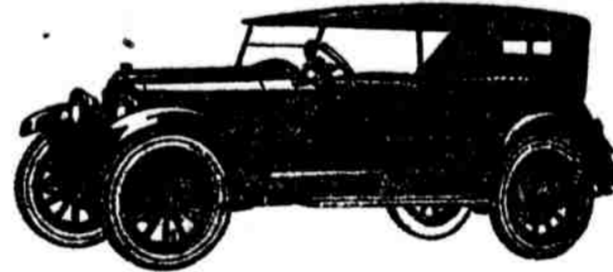
