G. O. P. OPPOSES KLAN

Dallas, Tex., Aug. 25.—The Ku Klux Klan promises to be an issue in Texas politics until after the final election in November. It has become a vital issue in the Democratic Party, especially in the race for Democratic nomination for United States Senator, and is creeping into the race for nomination for Texas State office. It also has become a bitter issue in certain counties.
