

LABOR PAST WAR CRISIS, SAYS DAVIS

Wage Levels Maintained in Face of Unemployment and Reactionary Employers INDUSTRIAL PEACE URGED

By Associated Press. Washington, Ill., Sept. 4.—American labor has made great strides in the last year, Secretary Davis of the Labor Department declared today in a Labor Day address. In spite of unemployment, he said, it has fought off all attempts to decrease wage levels set up during the war, and safely passed a war crisis. "Despite the pressure of a tremendous mass of unemployed, despite the efforts of a few reactionary employers who selfishly sought to take advantage of the distress of labor and the Nation, we have kept the general level of wages up," he declared. "I am safe in saying the average compensation of the non-war year is within a few per cent of what it was a year ago, and wage levels passed an unbroken crisis."
