

OPPOSES ENDING AUTO RECIPROcity

Proposed Monthly Fee Unworkable, Declares Motor Commissioner of New Jersey

FREEHOLDERS ARE WARNED

Law Hopalong, N. J., Sept. 12.—Taking issue with A. R. Kohler, freeholder of Gloucester County, who suggested a monthly license fee from foreign motorists using New Jersey roads at a recent meeting of the Association of Freeholders of that State, William L. Dill, Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, yesterday wrote the association that the idea was "absolutely unworkable." Mr. Dill warned that while a few additional dollars might be collected, the license would follow and...

"I believe we will collect this year from non-resident motorists in excess of \$300,000 and it is a good policy to limit reciprocity to fifteen days, as our law does, especially in view of the fact we are the gateway between the two great States of Pennsylvania and New York, but to deny reciprocity to all when millions of dollars are invested in hotels along the Atlantic Ocean would be to discriminate against an industry that has taken years to build up, and which has made New Jersey famous."

"In my opinion it is not the New Jersey law which requires amendment but rather the Pennsylvania law, and I told Mr. Kohler his organization of farmers should interest similar organizations in the State of Pennsylvania and go before the Legislature of that State next January and advocate an amendment to the Pennsylvania law which will eliminate the distinction which now prevails in that State as between commercial vehicles and vehicles of the commercial type, placing them on the same basis as in New Jersey for it is this differentiation that has caused all the trouble."

"I willingly grant that South Jersey especially is overrun with Pennsylvania cars in the height of the summer season and that many of them do not take out New Jersey licenses, but I want to say the vast majority of these motorists that pass the entire season in New Jersey do register with us, to say nothing of the large sums of money which these tourists spend while visiting in our State."

"If the differentiation existent in Pennsylvania is eliminated, and I shall be glad indeed to bring this about, I am convinced that the trouble which the South Jersey farmers have encountered at the hands of the Pennsylvania authorities this year will be terminated."

HONDURAN REBELS ROUTED

Nicaragua and Honduras Plan United Drive on Revolutionaries Tegucigalpa, Honduras, Sept. 12.—Rebel forces commanded by Rufino Solis have been defeated by Government troops at Iari. The Government forces captured 14,000 rifles and quantities of war material. A conference is being held at Esquipulas between Nicaraguan and Honduran Government generals for the purpose of finding ways and means for a concerted drive against all rebels and the capture of Solis. The rebel general, Louis Mauli, has been killed in battle.
