POINCARE GREETED BURTON

American Member of Funding Board Confers With Premier. Paris, Sept. 16.—By A. P.—Representative Theodore H. Burton, of Ohio, member of the War Debt Funding Commission, was received by Premier Poincaré today. Mr. Burton was accompanied by Sheldon Whitehouse, counselor of the American Embassy, in the absence of Ambassador Herrick. The Premier and the representative engaged in informal conversation, which lasted nearly twenty minutes, during which the situation in Europe and in the Near East was discussed.

Smyrna Devastated by Fire and Plague

Continued from Page One. quotes an American relief worker as declaring that up to Thursday morning there had been 120,000 victims. It is thought this figure may include the wounded also, as preliminary reports placed the number of dead at from 1000 to 2000.

Official dispatches received from Smyrna today state that all the foreign consulates were destroyed by fire, with the exception of those of Spain, Belgium and Norway.

Landward from the city it is reported that all the villages are burning, and that the whole countryside has been devastated.

Meanwhile the Turkish forces in the north have continued their advance, and almost simultaneously with the advance of the Turkish forces in the north, the British fleet in the Dardanelles has been ordered to prevent any attempt to cross the straits, and that ships will be allowed to concentrate for the purpose of transferring troops in a movement toward Thrace.

Jugo-Slavia and Rumania also are reported to be cooperating with the Turkish forces. The British Government is especially concerned over the neutrality of Constantinople and the Straits, and it is reported that the French and Italian troops are also under orders to increase their vigilance in the neutral zone, and that some have already been landed at points hitherto unoccupied.

Belgrade, Sept. 16.—By A. P.—Rumania and Jugo-Slavia have completed an exchange of views regarding the attitude they will adopt in the case the Bulgarian Government should attempt to cooperate with the Greek Government to suppress the Greek viewpoint in regard to Thrace.

Constantinople, Sept. 16.—By A. P.—Renewed celebrations were held throughout Asia Minor yesterday to mark the seventh Turkish victory over the Greeks. Bonus Bill Provides Three Optional Plans

The Soldiers' Bonus Bill, which would become effective January 1, 1923, provides three optional plans for the World War veterans, other than those whose adjusted service pay would not exceed \$50. The options are:

Adjusted service certificates, payable in twenty years or sooner at death and containing loan provisions. These certificates would have a face value equal to the sum of the adjusted service credit of the veteran, increased by 25 per cent, plus interest thereon for twenty years.

Vocational training aid at the rate of \$1.75 a day up to a total of 140 per cent of the adjusted service credit. Aid in purchasing a farm or home, the total amount to range from 100 per cent of the adjusted service credit (if the money was advanced in 1923) to 140 per cent of the adjusted service credit, if the payment was made in 1925 or thereafter.

HOUSE APPROVES TARIFF. NOW AWAITS SENATE MOVE

P.)—Finally approved by the House 210 to 90, the Administration tariff bill became again today the unfinished business of the Senate. Republican leaders expected final legislative action on the bill before the end of next week.

FRENCH SEAMEN STRIKE

Modification of Eight-Hour Law Opposed by Sailors. Marseilles, Sept. 16.—By A. P.—A strike of seamen in protest against the governmental decree modifying the eight-hour law on French vessels went into effect here today. Sailors went ashore, leaving aboard the ships only sufficient men to ensure the safety of the vessels.
