

WAS HYPNOTIZED, ROBBED MAN SAYS

**Victim Cannot Remember What
Happened After Handkerchief
Was Placed Over Eyes**

LOSES HARD-EARNED \$350

Police are looking today for two robbers who may be, according to Robert Weiner, 1342 North Marshall street, hypnotize their victims and then rob them.

At least, that is what they did to him, he told the police. First, they passed a handkerchief over his face, which put him under a spell. Then they took the \$350 he had saved since the purchase of eight years he has been in this country.

Weiner, who is twenty-five years old, said he was attacked at Seventh and Parrish streets early yesterday by a man who inspired for the time, nothing. 7:15 P.M.—She sets forth from her home.

7:30 P.M.—The Rev. Edward Wheeler Hall leaves his home.

8 P.M.—Mrs. Mills seen by trolley motorman leaving car at Bucleugh Park, near spot where bodies were later discovered.

8:15 P.M.—Mrs. Hall seen walking near vocational school in neighborhood of Bucleugh Park.

Night—Mrs. Hall at her home and Mr. Mills at his home begin to worry about the absence of their mates.

FRIDAY

2 A.M.—Mrs. Hall seeks her husband at the church, thinking he may have fallen asleep in his study.

2:15 A.M.—Mrs. Mills goes to the church to pray.

2:30 A.M.—Mrs. Hall notifies her lawyer of her husband's absence.

2:45 A.M.—Mrs. Hall notifies chief of police that her husband is missing.

SATURDAY

3:30 A.M.—Bodies of murdered couple found.

Though no one has been known to have seen the bodies since the shooting, there have been times when Mrs. Mills has responded to her husband's name. That was still in a moment, and as we stood, staring and debating, three policemen stood by the road in quick order.

**JAPANESE INDICTED
