

"EVERY man in a sport" is the slogan at Swarthmore. What better ideal could the little Quakers have us their goal? For years the National Collegiate Association has pounded this idea into the representatives of the various institutions which comprise its membership,

The aim has been mass athletics rather than specialized athletics, but sports for the masses is impossible at some of our larger universities. At Pennsylvania, for instance, what chance has every one of the 12,000 students to participate in athletics? All the playgrounds in the city would not

be large enough to accommodate them. But at Swarthmere it is different, and so is the idea somewhat different. Instead of mass athletics confined to monotonous calisthenics, the Quakers intend to get every student out for some branch of sport already established.

With this in mind, Swarthmore has signed Frank Fitts, Garnet football star of a half decade ago, as assistant physical director under Dr. Roy Mercer. Close to 100 are out for football and more than forty candidates for the secret team. This means that more than half of the male students are endeavoring to make the first team in two sports. The backward minority will be conxed and then commanded to report for

some other sport by Fitts, who will devote considerable time to the students who are not of varsity caliber. If Swarthmore never wins another football game, or a baseball game, or basketball game, the Quakers need not hang their heads in shame. As long as the suburban students continue to develop themselves physically

through sports, the Garnet will gain more glory than any victory over a rival
