

DAVIS URGES SAVING WAGE FOR AMERICAN WORKER
 Secretary Says Harding Stresses Value of Rail Workers
 Detroit, Oct. 4.—(By A. P.)—President Harding "believes that the railroad worker is of such importance in our national existence that his wages and the conditions under which he works should be such as to make his employment so attractive that strikes will be impossible." Secretary Davis of the Labor Department declared here today in addressing the convention of United Brotherhood of Maintenance of

Way Employees and Railway Shop Laborers.
 The secretary also advocated a "saving wage" for the "American worker."
 "More and more American employers are seeing the wisdom of the saving wage," he continued. "This wage principle promotes happiness and contentment in the workman's home, and increases the buying power of the great group of American wage-earners upon whom we depend to buy a great part of our great industrial output."
 "We have had too much violence in our industrial life," he added, "too much strife, too much bloodshed. Labor must be ever alert to prevent those unlawful outbreaks which disgrace our whole civilization."
