Pointe-a-Pitre, Martinique, Oct. 12.—The aviator Hinton today left for Rio de Janeiro, where he is reported to have landed safely.

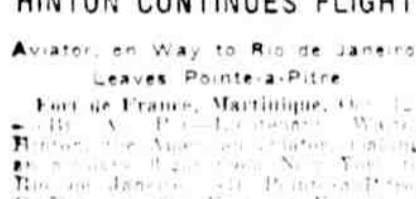
DRIVES INTO RIVER TO DEATH

PENITENTIARY CAN'T BAR PRISONERS. IS RULING

Fact They Should Have Been Sent Elsewhere Doesn't Affect Case

The board of inspectors of the Eastern Penitentiary cannot refuse to admit into that institution prisoners sentenced there by judges even though, under the law, they should have been sent to county prisons, according to an opinion by Emerson L. Collins, Deputy Attorney General.

Mr. Collins submitted his opinion to former Congressman J. Washington Logan, secretary of the board of inspectors of the institution. Mr. Logan had asked for an opinion as a result of many prisoners being sent to the penitentiary who, the board contends, should have been sent elsewhere.

The board "cannot subordinate the legality of such a sentence," Mr. Collins said in his opinion. Mr. Logan in explaining the attitude of the board said that under the law, where the punishment is simple, the prisoner should be sent to the county prison. It is only in cases where the law provides imprisonment at labor or solitary confinement that prisoners should be committed to the penitentiary, he argued.
