

BRITISH POLITICS AT FEVER HEIGHT

Mail Asserts Premier Will Resign if Unionists Drop Chamberlain

DISSOLUTION IS EXPECTED

London, Oct. 18.—The British political fever has now reached its height, and there is every indication that maximum temperature will be maintained for some days. Everybody is guessing as to when the crisis will pass and what turn it will take, but the answer is as yet unrevealed and the future remains obscure pending tomorrow's Unionist meeting at the Carlton Club, which is expected to give the key to the problem.

One anti-coalition newspaper, the Daily Mail, today attributes to Prime Minister Lloyd George the definite statement that he will resign office if the Unionist meeting declares against his coalition. Lloyd George's outburst against the Premier has aroused strong opposition in the party ranks. Mr. Lloyd George's statement is said to have been made at a private meeting last night of the Liberal Ministers and Under-Secretaries. None of the papers nearest the Premier, nor any other, confirms this or professes to know exactly what passed at the meeting, although all agree that Lloyd George received general cordial support.

Whether or not the Premier made the declaration attributed to him, some of the best informed political correspondents believe he will resign if Mr. Chamberlain's resignation is not accepted at the Carlton Club. It would then be up to the King to determine whether to dissolve Parliament, or to invite the Conservative Party to try its hand at forming a government.
