

**SAYS VARE PAID
IDA RIEHL DEFENSE**

Scott Reveals Late Senator as Benefactor of Girl Who Killed Alleged Betrayer

CASE STIRRED CITY IN 1916

Senator Vare financed the defense of Ida Riehl six years ago when the girl was tried for slaying the youth she said had betrayed her, according to John R. K. Scott.

Mr. Scott, who was the girl's counsel, said that Senator Vare paid \$11,000, covering all the expense of the legal battle which led to Ida's acquittal on June 21, 1916.

Ida Riehl married several years after her acquittal. After the ceremony, Mr. Scott says, she called at his office in the Lincoln Building.

"I am going to show you who paid all the expenses of your defense," Mr. Scott had told her. He led the grateful young woman to Senator Vare's office in the same building.

Ward leaders and others waiting in an anteroom noticed at the lawyer as he entered with the pretty young woman in tow. A whispered word to the Senator's secretary obtained instant admission to Vare's private office.

Ida, says Mr. Scott, shyly grasped the Senator's hand and in faltering tones and with a trace of tears in her eyes began thanking him for his generosity. But he interrupted.

"Oh, that's all right, little girl," he assured her. "It's all in the day's work."

After the trial of the Senator yesterday, Mr. Scott related the incident. The girl, she is Edward Carl Hatag, a former on May 22, 1915. He had refused to marry her. The case aroused wide interest, since it was intertwined with the birth of a child a few months before Ida was brought to trial, charged with second-degree murder.

Mrs. Isaac T. Shoemaker, 6910 Mower street, wife of a contractor, had signed Ida's \$2000 bail bond.

Ida was then eighteen years old and Mrs. Shoemaker kept her at her home for a while until her fiancé's nerves were soothed.

Mrs. Shoemaker is now living on Long Island.
