Nationalist Leaders to Meet King

By Associated Press Rome, Oct. 27 .- Benito Mussolini, leader of the Fascisti, is expected to arribe in Rome today, having been called here by Premier Facta, who wishes to discuss the situation with him.

This action has again caused rumors to circulate that the formation of auother Facta Cabinet with the participation of the Fascistl is a possibility.

All speculations concerning the solution of the crisis agree that it will result in the advent to power of the Fascisti, either alone or with Giolitti. Orlando or Salandra, in case the Fact Cabinet possibility mentioned is dissi-

pated.

King Victor Emmanuel will arrive in Rome tonight. He has expressed a desire to consult tomorrow on the situation with Signors Tittoni and De Nicola, the presidents, respectively, of the Senate and the Chamber of Deputies, with Benito Mussolini, the leader of the Fascisti, and with Luigi Federzoni, leader of the Nationalist party. Former Premier Giolitti also will be

in Rome tomorrow.

In an interview in the Giornale d'Italia, Michele Bianchi, secretary of clared that if logic, common sense and constitutional customs were to be fol-lowed, only Mussolini could be intrusted with the formation of a new cabinet.

The meeting of the Fascisti at Naples

and the speech delivered there by Mus-solini have caused the present crisis. Signor Bianchi pointed out, and there-fore it was Musselini who had overthrown the cabinet and must form the

new administration.

The secretary refused to admir the possibility of any other solution of the crisis, but if for the sake of discussion another course should be contemplated, the Fascisti, he considered, should ask a larger participation in the new cabinet than that mentioned by Musselim in his speech, when he said he had de-manded for the Fascisti the portfolics of foreign affairs, war, navy, labor and Public works.

He should also demand the portfolio

of the interior, Signor Bianchi thought. London, Oct. 27.—(By A. P.) -While the larest news from Rome shows a continuance of a crisis in Italy there is nothing in the advices received today

to indicate that anything in the nature of a revolution is in progress.

Some Rome messages predict the crisis will be specific settled. Meanwhile the report through Paris that the Fascisti wars to anything the respect to the crisis will be specific settled. Fascisti were marching on Rome without any confirmation.
