

TURKEY AUCTION STIRS HATFIELD

Only 1500 Birds Due for Annual Vendue, With Demand for More

TWO SALES THURSDAY

Fifteen hundred turkeys arrived last night in Hatfield, Montgomery County, and the stage is all set for the two big turkey auctions scheduled for Thursday morning.

These turkey auctions, held annually, and preceding both the Thanksgiving and Christmas holiday seasons, have given Hatfield a State-wide reputation. They do not, contrary to general belief, establish the "Philadelphia price" for turkey. The total number of turkeys sold at the auctions rarely exceeds 2000, and this year the total is only 1500, not more than 25 per cent of which reaches the tables of Philadelphia. The demand locally has become so large that the greater part is taken by Bucks and Montgomery Counties, and principally in Boylston, Lansdale and Norristown.

One thousand birds from Virginia will be offered at the first auction at the market, or "strut" lot, in Hatfield. When this is finished, 500 turkeys from Ohio will go on the block, at the "lower" hotel, two squares away. All the leading hotels of Philadelphia, including the "Turkey King," will attend. Many dealers from the suburban section and a few from Philadelphia are expected to appear.

There will be few Pennsylvania turkeys on any market this year. Bucks County, once a good producing field, does not turn out enough turkeys annually to supply the Thanksgiving demands of any two large Philadelphia hotels. Largest shipments will come from Virginia and Ohio, and some from Maryland.
