

# SANTA DISMAYED AT N. J. TAX BILLS

### Christmas Savings Will Be Cut Into by Payments to Government

### BANKS RELEASING MILLIONS

Special Dispatch to Evening Public Ledger. Pitman, N. J., Nov. 27.—Millions of dollars in the aggregate will be released for the payment of taxes and for Christmas shopping through savings banks by banks in South Jersey, between Camden and the shore, this week. Total amounts to be paid out are said by bankers to exceed all previous years. In spite of more or less unsettled local news and industrial conditions during 1922.

More clubs and more members, who have found this an easy way to be in funds at the end of the year, by saving, are responsible for this increase in holiday savings. Most of the banks are planning to mail their checks on or before December 15, which is the final day for the payment of taxes.

While tax collectors are asking Santa Claus a run for the money, due to the fact that tax bills are payable now, more than three weeks before Christmas, instead of on December 20, as under the old taxing system, bankers say there is actually more money to be distributed for holiday shopping than for taxes.

Such a liberal distribution of funds of such large amounts in the 24,000,000 population of the State is being looked for by merchants and business men to stimulate holiday business throughout South Jersey and in the Philadelphia district, and to be the really most effective incentive to this year's Christmas shopping.

By reason of this schedule for the distributing of saving clubs' checks and the fact that many other citizens who are not members of the clubs have delayed the paying of their taxes until the last minute, tax collectors are again for a rush at their offices this week. Some municipalities postponed weekly payments in previous years by offering a discount on tax bills paid in full, but this discount was given to be legal and was discontinued this year.

Third Floor of Silver Lake Hotel Damaged by Blaze. The third floor of the Silver Lake Hotel, White Horse Pike, between Washington and Clementon, N. J., was damaged by fire yesterday afternoon as the premises were preparing for this year's dining guests.

A guest went to his room on the third floor and found it filled with smoke. The chimney was a fire and the flames reached the woodwork in the room. When firemen from nearby communities arrived the flames had spread throughout the floor.
