SOVIET AND TURKS WORK TOGETHER

Other Delegates at Lausanne Wonder What Alliance Will Hatch Out

RUSSIANS CITE U. S. POLICY

Lausanne, Nov. 28.—Russia and Turkey, working together, are expected to make a strong pair at Lausanne, and other delegates to the Near East Conference are wondering what effect the combination will have.

English and French circles show a disposition to reject the demands forwarded by the Russian delegation, insisting that Russia be heard not only in the Dardanelles discussion, but in all questions on the conference agenda.

It is pointed out that Russia has signed a peace treaty with Turkey and that, therefore, there is no reasonable basis for her demand that she participate in the general deliberations to determine the terms of a settlement between Greece and Turkey on one hand, and Turkey and the Allies on the other.

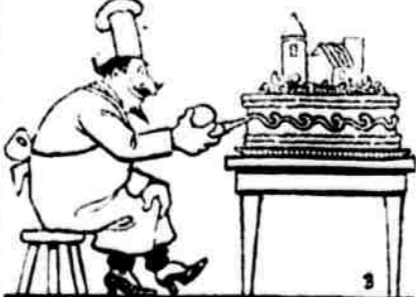
