

PASTOR DENOUNCES KLAN FOR DEVILTRY

Delaware Parson Says U. S. Has No Room for Bigots or Demagogues

BLAST AT WILLIAMSPORT

Laurel, Del., Dec. 1.—Before a large congregation in Christ Methodist Protestant Church at the union Thanksgiving service yesterday, the Rev. W. O. Bennett, of Centenary Methodist Episcopal Church, denounced Klans and all other "isms" that are trying to bring about class and sectarian hatred.

"In a democracy like the United States there is no room for the demagogue or bigot," Dr. Bennett said. "When I was a boy, he continued, I was deeply impressed with a picture of the devil that filled a page in the old family Bible. But now I've changed my mind as to the appearance of a devil, and when I see or hear of a man or a body of men banding together going about sowing seeds of class hatred, trying to poison the minds of a class against another, teaching the non-Christian doctrine of Gentile-hood against the Jew, Protestantism against Catholicism, then I say there is a devil far more monstrous and more hellish than the pictured devil as represented in my old family Bible."

Washington, Dec. 1.—South American diplomats and high officials of the United States listened yesterday at the Pan-American mass that has become a Washington tradition on Thanksgiving while the Rev. Patrick J. Healy, of the Catholic University, told them the Ku Klux Klan was a menace to religious freedom and the Constitution.

Archbishop Curley presided at the mass in St. Patrick's Church with diplomatic representatives of every other American nation, and representatives of the legislative, executive and judicial branches of the Government in attendance.

Healy referred to the recent speech of Secretary Denny, who said, "Nothing more dangerous to the constituted republic and spiritual health of the American nation, and representative of these much secret societies as the Klan. Dr. Healy preached the day's sermon, in the course of which he said: "Religious freedom is the most sacred possession of free peoples. Yet, if we say to believe the tales told with such seeming truth and so frequently, religious freedom itself is menaced in certain parts of this country."

"When a responsible official, a member of the President's Cabinet, finds it necessary to address such words to his fellow countrymen, and when the daily papers are filled with reports that substitute his fears that freedom is menaced in this country, there can be no doubt as to the direction in which patriotic duty lies."

Williamsport, Dec. 1.—The explosion of fifty pounds of dynamite on the top of a mountain hill north of this city caused the windows rattle and caused considerable excitement Wednesday night. People rushed into the streets to see what was the matter and those not near enough to see the explosion on the hill, the burning cross of the Ku Klux Klan. The report that a motor was burning on the drive on the hill after exploding sent many to the hill to help. They found the ground about the cross strewn with Ku Klux Klan literature.
