

POLICE AND AUTO BANDITS IN FIGHT

One of Two Stolen Cars Recovered After Pistol Chase on North Broad Street

ONE SUSPECT IS CAUGHT

Automobile bandits and police fought on North Broad street this morning shortly after midnight in an exciting chase of several blocks. The bandits rode in two automobiles which had been stolen in Chestnut Hill and Oak Lane. Three bullets were fired into one of the cars by the police and the driver was finally captured at Broad street and Roosevelt boulevard when the machine crashed into a pole. The other car and its occupants escaped. Police of Branchtown station received a telephone call shortly after

midnight that the car of Joseph A. Slattery, Hillside drive, Chestnut Hill, had been stolen and that the thieves were coming down Broad street. A few minutes later a similar call came from Oak Lane. Signals of Patrolman Hibbard at Broad street and Olney avenue to stop were ignored by the thieves, and the officer swung onto the running board of another machine. The policeman then took up the chase and engaged in a running pistol fight with the thieves. The man arrested gave his name as Edward J. Murray and said he lived at 2552 Girard avenue. Later he said his name is Edward J. Shay and that he lives on Twenty-ninth street near Allegheny avenue. The car stolen in Oak Lane is that of Dr. T. Redding, 1508 Lawton avenue.

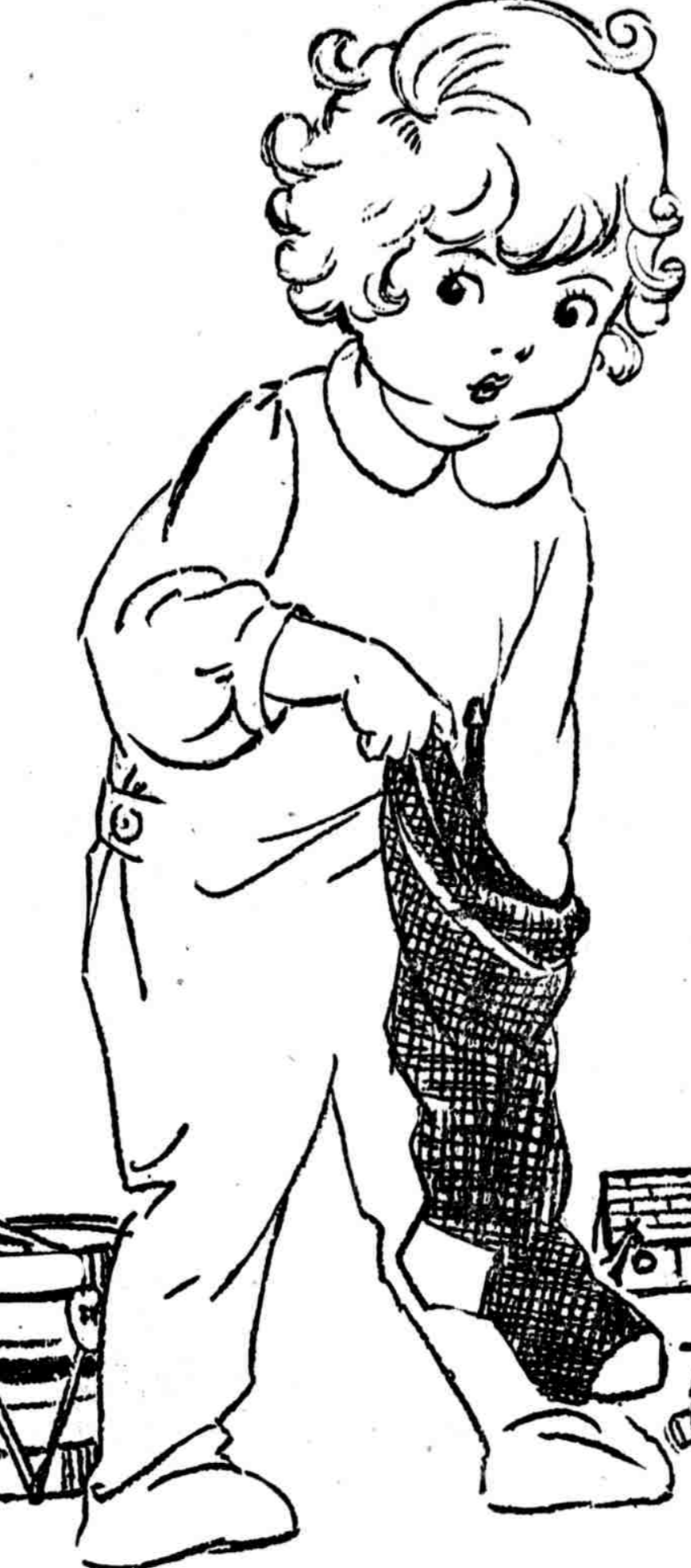
WOMAN HURT BY TROLLEY
