

PLAN MORATORIUM TO HELP GERMANY

Allied Premiers to Tackle Entire Reparations Question at Paris Conference

WILL MEET NEXT TUESDAY

Paris, Dec. 28.—As a result of exchanges of views since the London meeting of the Premiers the Allies have decided to go over the entire question of reparations in detail at the Paris conference to begin next Tuesday.

The general opinion in Germany is that the possibility of putting her on her feet through an international loan and a moratorium and extension of the length of the moratorium necessary for her recovery will probably be the first item on the order of business.

While the conference will go into the question of reparations, it is thought in French official quarters that little will be accomplished by this conference beyond the fixing of a moratorium on the reparations and regarding guarantees that will probably be taken.

French Opinion Against Reduction of Reparations. French public opinion is generally against any reduction in the reparations total as it is to accept the idea of a moratorium without guarantee.

Concerning the proposed moratorium conference, it was considered that the French government has shown that it favors such a conference by insisting upon the holding of a special conference for the discussion of reparations and international debts.

France Favors Conference. President Harding's letter to Senate Lodge is interpreted as showing a leaning toward the desire of the President to obtain sufficient freedom to enable him to treat the debt question with a little more freedom.
