THE PRESIDENT'S PROCLAMATION. The President to-day issued the following: EXECUTIVE MANSION, WASHINGTON, D. C. Nov. 18 1886.

Done at the city of Washington, this eighteenth day of November, in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-Six, and of the Independence of the United States of America One Hundred and Eleventh.
