

SWALLOWED UP BY FIRE.

Horrible Death of Eleven Girls at Plymouth, Pa.

CHARRED BEYOND RECOGNITION.

Death Comes During a Pleasant After Dinner Chat—A Large Squib Factory Instantly Wrecked by Mysterious Explosions—Blackened Bodies and Bones.

WILKESBARRE, Pa., Feb. 26.—Eleven girls, varying in age from 13 to 22 years, lost their lives in Powell's squib factory at Plymouth yesterday afternoon.

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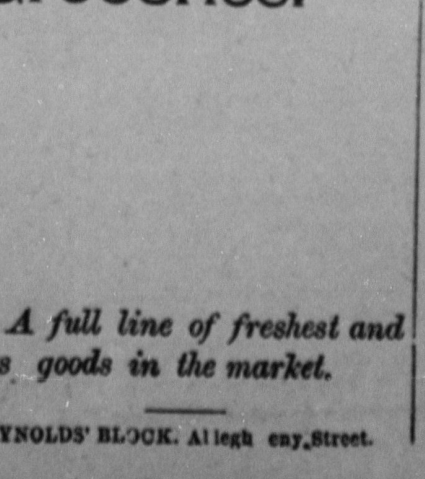
