### MANY COMMITTEES APPOINTED.

A Minority Report of the Constitution Committee Favors Women Delegates-A Commit-Etee of One 111 to Consider Prohibition and Temperance.

OMAHA, Neb., May 3 .- When Bishop Bowman rapped to order the first busi-ness session of the twenty-first general conference of the Methodist Episcopal church the immense auditorium of the Boyd theater hardly sufficed to accommodate the immense throng of delegates and visitors attracted by the meeting. It is estimated that in addition to the 500 regular delegates present there are fully 4,000 visitors in attendance. The six tiers of boxes were occupied by the wives and families of the eighteen bishops of the church.

The conference was opened by scrip tural reading by Bishop Newman, fol-lowed by prayer by Bishop Foss. At conclusion of roll call the confer-ence proceeded to the election of a secre-

Dr. S. D. Monroe, of Pennsylvatary. nia, the former secretary, and Dr. Manley S. Hard, of Wyoming, were candidates for the position. When the result of the ballot was announced **Dr**. Monroe was declared elected secretary by a nearly two-thirds majority. He immediately announced as his assistants Manley S. Hard, of Wyoming, and Charles Hudson, of Indiana.

A motion to seat lay and ministerial delegates in separate parts of the hall produced a lengthy discussion. The re-quest was granted, the vote on the ques-tion being: Ministerial, yeas, 162; nays, 136. Laymen, yeas, 105; nays, 61.

OMABA, Neb. May 4 .- The task of satisfying the clamoring seat hunting delegates finally became too heavy for Bish-Foster, and being appointed to read Episcopal address, which contains the 76,000 words, he yielded the chair to Bishop Andrews in order to save his voice, which was fast failing him. ## FIFTY-SECOND CONGRESS.

#### Condensed Report of Proceedings in Senate and House.

WASHINGTON, May 3 .- In the Senate Mr. Vest handed up a petition protesting against opening the World's fair on Sunday, and threatening by resolution to taboo all congress-men who failed to support the closing of the exposition on that day. He said that as a sen-ator he should vote on the question without paying the slightest attention to the important resolution. The petition was referred. (After business of a routine nature the sente passed several public building bills and went into executive session on the Russian and French extradition treaties. In the house several important bills were passed under suspension of the rules, including the bill to place bilding the rules, the true list. Among the other **mass** ures were: A bill to encourage American this building, which authorizes a United States  $r_{f}$ ister to such foreign built stcamships of 40% tons or over sailing in established lines from tons or over saming in established lines from foreign ports to this country, of which net leas than 00 per cent of the capital was owned by citizens of the United States; granting a pen-sion of \$8 per month to the survivors of the Black Hawk, Creek, Cherokee and Seminole mars to ratify and confirm an agreement with the Indians residing in the Colville reservation in the State of Washington; appropriating \$150,000 to carry out the stipulations regarding

S150,000 to carry out the superations regarding the Behring sea treaty. WASHINGTON, May 4.—The senate, with a scant quorum present, by a vote of 35 to 15 passed the amended Chinese exclusion bill, passed the amended Chinese exclusion bill, disregarding the protest of Mr. Sherman that the new section requiring all Chinese in the United States to register within a year or be imprisoned was a violation of treaty obliga-tions with China. Mr. Morgan called up the president's bimetallic conference message in order to give Mr. Kyle, of South Dakota, the opportunity to make a free comage silver speech. The time of the house was occupied in further debate on the diplomatic and con-sular appropriation bill, which was finally passed. The most important changes in the bill, as reported by the committee were the items restoring the Danish mission and the re-jection of the appropriation of \$55,600 for the continental railway survey. There was some discussion on the item regarding the bureau of American republics, which was finally reof American republics, which was finally retained in the bill.

#### KEYSTONE STATE NEWS.

SHAMOKIN, Pa., May 3 .- Philip Weist was struck by a falling timber yester-day afternoon in the Henry Clay mines and was instantly killed.

AshLAND, Pa., May 3. - Thomas Kohler, a lad of 13 years, was fatally injured by the explosion of a dual cap at his home in Locust Date. Both of his hands were blown off, and his face badly injured. He was cutting the cap at the time of the accident.

PHILADELPHIA, May 3 .- The supreme court affirmed the jadgments of the county courts of Philadelphia, Lebanon and Lackawanna counties, sustaining the constitutionality of the "ballot reform bill" of June 9, 1891. The appeals were taken principally on behalf of the Prohibition party by members of that organization.

WILLIAMSPORT, Pa., May 3.-The Re-publican conference of the Sixteenth district, comprising Clinton, Potter, Tioga and Lycoming, met at the Upedraff house last night for the purpage of choas-ing two delegates to the national con-vention. All the counties were repre-sented. A. M. Bennett, of Tioga, and W. I. Lewis, of Potter, were chosen delegates to the national convertion.

READING, Pa., May 3 .- The captain of the Salvation Army had a hearing be-fore Mayor Merritt on the charge of obstructing the sidewalk and creating a disturbance at Third and Penn streets, the terminus of the Reading and Southwestern Electric railway. She was bent upon holding services at that point and refused to move on when directed by Police Sergeant Meyer. The captain was discharged with a reprimand.

PITTSBURG, May 3 .- Something of a sensation was created on the street in front of St. Mary's Catholic church, Moun't Washington, by Mary Cameron, a crazy woman, assaulting Bev. Father O'Connell with a hatchet. Finding that he could not overpower her, Father O'Connell drew a revolver, but by this time assistance arrived and the woman was arrested. It seems that many years ago Mrs. Cameron lost her property through litigation, and that at that time a priest testified against her. The loss turned her brain and she has had an antipathy to priests ever since. HARRISBURG, May 8 .- The Philadelphia and Reading Railroad company has made answer to the suit against the socalled Reading combine, and the attor-ney general will file an answer denying all the reasons advanced by the company for the move taken in combining the railroads. The Philadelphia and Reading company has submitted a sepa-rate answer and demurer setting forth in detail all the railroads and branches owned or controlled in Pennsylvania. As soon as the papers can be pregared the court will appoint a master to take testimony in the case.






