

Continued from page 2 banking firm of Kean, van Cortlandt & Co. of New York.

At the present time trolley lines are being built from Rochester to Buffalo and from Buffalo to Cleveland, while lines are already under operation from Cleveland to Toledo and from Toledo to Detroit.

The present purpose of the company is to control the terminal facilities in the lake cities. Lines in and around Buffalo have a mileage of 356, in Detroit of 536 and in Toledo of 112, and it is now predicted that within two years there will be a continuous trolley line from New York to Detroit.

Three men control the vast interests thus merged in the Tractional company. They are G. Louis Holsen of Kean, Van Cortlandt & Co., Henry J. Pierce of Buffalo and Nelson Robinson, Grant B. Schley and T. De Witt Cuyler are also directors.

Henry J. Pierce has been chosen president of the new company and Nelson Robinson vice president.

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A local paper had made use of the experiment as an advertising dodge by having the aeronaut drop a number of checks, ranging from \$1 to \$100, as he flew over the streets and house-tops of the city.

On his return trip the airship made headway against a pretty stiff wind.
