Monday being the time set for the reorganization of the Bellefonte Council for the coming year, a large number of persons assembled in the Council chamber. There were no changes in the personnel of this body of borough officials as Harry Keller, Philip Boezer and Dominick Judge were re-elected at the last election. The only thing necessary was re-organization which took place in the morning at 10 o'clock. Burgess John J. Boer was present and swore in the officers after which the Harper was chosen president in the place of Dominick Judge who retired with the thanks of the Council. William Kelley was chosen clerk of the council and the officers adjourned until evening at 7:30 o'clock. The first thing on the program in the evening session was the announcement of the several committees by President Harper which are as follows: Finance—Keller, Kirk and Judge; Water—Musser, Yergler and Judge; Street—Judge, Keller and Sheffer; Police—Boezer, Musser and Sheffer; Market—Grim, Sheffer and Boezer; Sanitary—Judge, Musser and Boezer; Hydro-Electric—Musser, Judge, Keller, Sheffer and Boezer; Village and Improvement—Yergler, Grim and Kirk. Samuel Showers and Thomas Jhaughnessy were applicants for Street Commissioner when the Harper was elected. The other officers filled were as follows: Water Superintendent, Samuel Rine, Solicitor, J. Thomas Mitchell, Borough Engineer, Henry A. Vetter, and the Board of Public Works, Harry Kelley was chosen for the position of Water Collector when Mr. Ishler was elected. Harry Dukeman and Daley Justice are still the policemen. They are good men for the position and their retention is all right. The next business of importance was with reference to the state road through Bellefonte. As is known the State authorities only brick nineteen feet in the centre of the street. The brick on each side must be done by either the Council or the property owners. It was the intention of President Harper to sign the contract as presented by the State but Kirk objected because all the preliminaries had not been agreed upon. For instance, a petition must be presented to the Council by some of the property owners, along the route, asking that the pavement be laid. Then an ordinance must be passed compelling those who do not sign the petition to lay their portion of the pavement. Neither of these things have been done and it was decided to leave the matter until next meeting night. At a previous meeting the clerk's salary was raised from \$12.50 to \$15 per month.
