Roadmaking Trusties.

It is proposed that the "trusties" in the new penitentiary shall be used for the making of roads through the state preserves, even though they are not regularly held there on work connected with the institution. For forty years he chafed under the stigma, knocking down with his fists any man who dared say he deserted. Finally City Treasurer A. L. Reichenback tackled Congress.

When Speaker Reed heard McLaughlin's story he got on the floor and in a wonderful speech secured the passage of a bill taking the gallant veteran from the deserters and putting him on the honor roll.

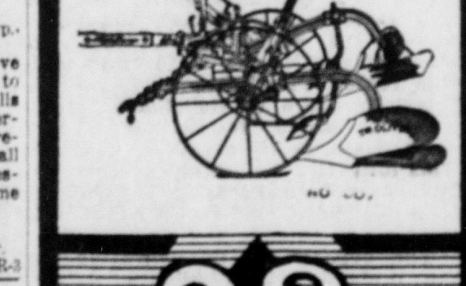
