and she was taken there after Hastings was captured. She told the nurses there that she thought the bullet was a firecracker. She is not seriously hurt.

Crowd Saw Street Battle. The large crowd was so curious at they jammed up within a few feet of the policemen. Bullets flew around in every direction. One of the officers was behind the corner of a house on Penn and Broad streets opposite the tree behind which Hastings took refuge. One of the shots landed in the wall of the shoe shop behind the tree. The owner, William Gordon was inside the shop only a few feet from where the shot enter-

As soon as Hasting was captured. a passing cab was commandered and Hastings shoved into it. Hastings began to talk about his injured arm Hastings and appeared very cool.
"This isn't serious, he said, "it is

only through the muscles."

After being fixed up at the hospital, Hastings was taken to the police sta-

Prisoner Talks Freely. Policeman Buch was with Hastings on the patrol wagon. As they drove away from the hospital Buch asked Hastings:

"What was your motive in shooting Mr. Hickok?" He said:
"Well, you know I am the brother of former Governor Hastings, and for the past fifteen years I have been trying to get \$69,000 that the estate owes me. Yesterday I wrote to Ross Hickok and told him that I wanted to talk about the matter with him, and I would be willing to compromise on one-tenth of that amount.

"Here I am with that money due without enough money to pay my board. That's a pretty way for me to be in isn't it?"

'Well, I went around to see Ross this afternoon, and he threw me out of the house, when I started to tell him what I wanted. Naturally I took a shot at him. I didn't want to kill him. If I had wanted to I could often have done it, when we have been alone together, and I could have killed him tonight. I just took a shot at him.'

Policeman Buch asked him why he had shot at the officers.
"You see I am an old soldier," the

old man said, "And you know how a soldier is when he is in danger or gets in a corner. His first impulse is to protect himself. Well I saw I was in a corner, and I don't know what it was except such an impulse that started me shooting. I was cornered and I just shot away."

When he reached the police station he was searched. Policeman Buch in going through his clothes, found a pen knife. Hastings remarked:

"I couldn't do much harm with Buch said it was dangerous and Hastings answered him: "I guess it would be if you knew

where to put it." Used Two Revolvers. A 32 calibre revolver and a 22 calibre automatic pistol were taken from

At the police station Hastings' age was entered on the docket at 73. The charge against him on the book is felonious assault.

He came in for a part of the Hastings fortune and after spending his share he attempted to attack Governor Hastings and he has lately attempted to force Mr. Ross Hickok to turn over \$300,000 to

He has been investigated for sanity and has spent some time in an asylum. He has also been in the penitentiary on charges, being convicted of forgery.

Hastings has been regarded as weak mentally for some time. One of his passions was writing letters to newspapers, long, voluminous epistles, telling in detail of alleged wrongs and imaginary grievances against his brother, the late Governor Hastings. Hastings wrote one of these when in Paris years ago. Its character was such that most editors heaved it into the waste basket. Such letters have been written recently, one of them being printed.

Victim Comfortable. At the Hickok residence Friday ight W. O. Hickok, III, a brother, told about the shooting and about the trouble the family has had with Hastings.

He said:
"Ross is resting comfortably. He is not seriously injured. I think he would have been killed had he not succeeded in putting the old man out of the vestibule.
