Considerable damage is done each summer in many home gardens by the Mexican bean beetle, reports County Agent R. C. Blaney.

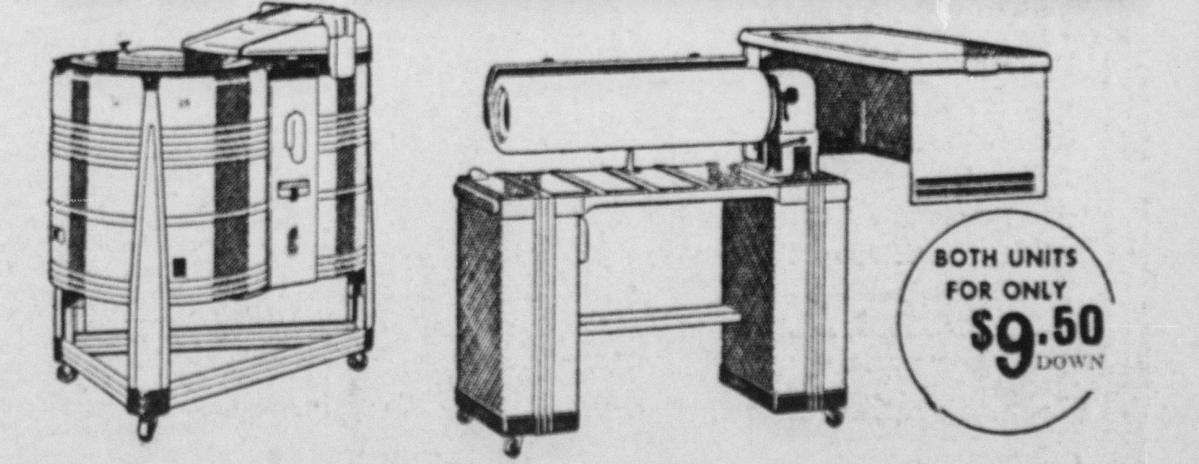
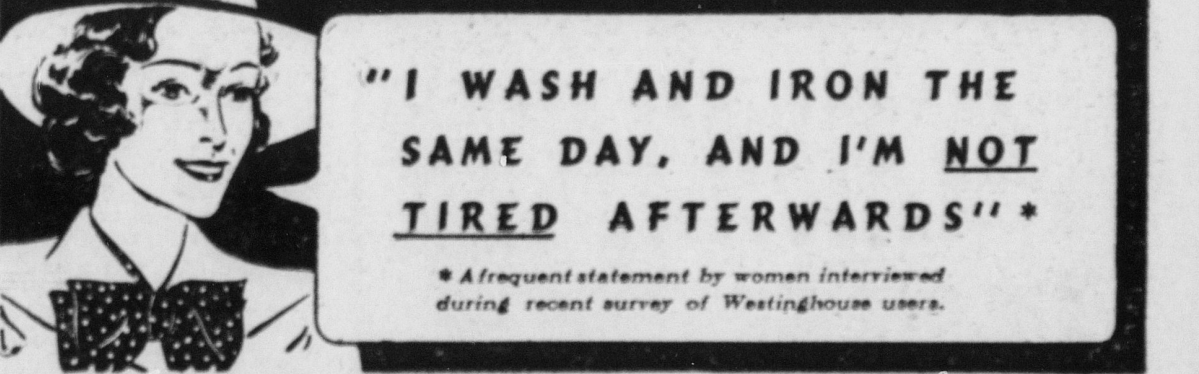
