whom you would talk. If possible it is a good thing to get to the meeting ahead of time, look over the place where you are to speak, take care of all details, and find out every bit of information you can about the audience.

There are certain definite procedures about the preparation of a speech. When you have an appointment to speak begin on the address immediately; do not delay. Examine your own thought and see what you know and think about the subject.

All of this takes hard work, but it is necessary. You can never convince or teach an audience unless you have a logical and concise idea and message in your own mind.

In closing his address Mr. Metcalfe summed up as cardinal principles: be yourself; do not skimp in preparation; dig deep and add to the wealth of your knowledge; coordinate and test your material; watch your words; build up your vocabulary; let the range of your voice be such as to fill the room in which you are speaking; and let there be clearness of tone and thought.
