sumed yesterday and Viehdorfer did not appear. Officers were sent out to bring him in. Upon his arrival at the Borough Building Dr. Heaton declared that there was no use taking testimony from the man, because of his condition. He is alleged to have been intoxicated.

The shooting of Mr. Hahn apparently happened while Quick and Viehdorfer were shooting at a bear which had been chased out of the woods during a drive conducted by other members of the party. The origin of the bullet which struck Hahn was entirely obscured until Saturday afternoon when Game Warden, inspecting the scene of the accident, came upon the blood-stained ground.

According to the story brought out at the inquest, officers said, Mr. Hahn, his son, Arthur, aged 17, and Charles Viehdorfer were walking up a woodland trail leading toward what are known as the Askey fields.

Members of the hunting party went to a nearby coal mine and were late in returning to the main road where Dr. E. H. Harris and Funeral Director V. H. Johnson, both of Snow Shoe, were notified. When they arrived at the scene the man was dead, indications being that he died instantly.

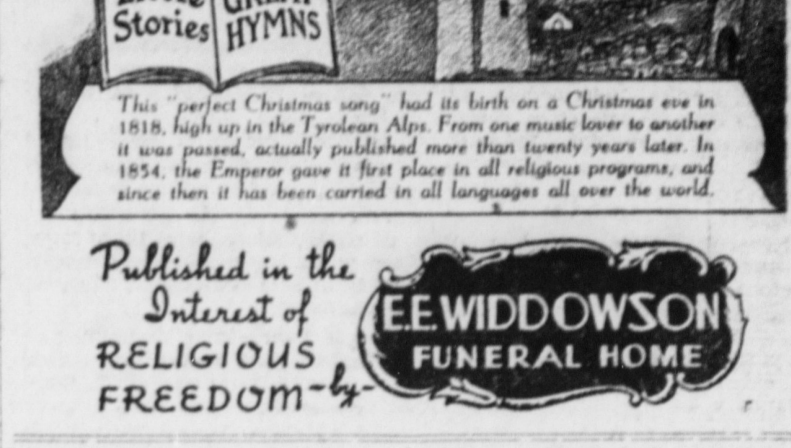
