Church Will Be Dedicated June 9

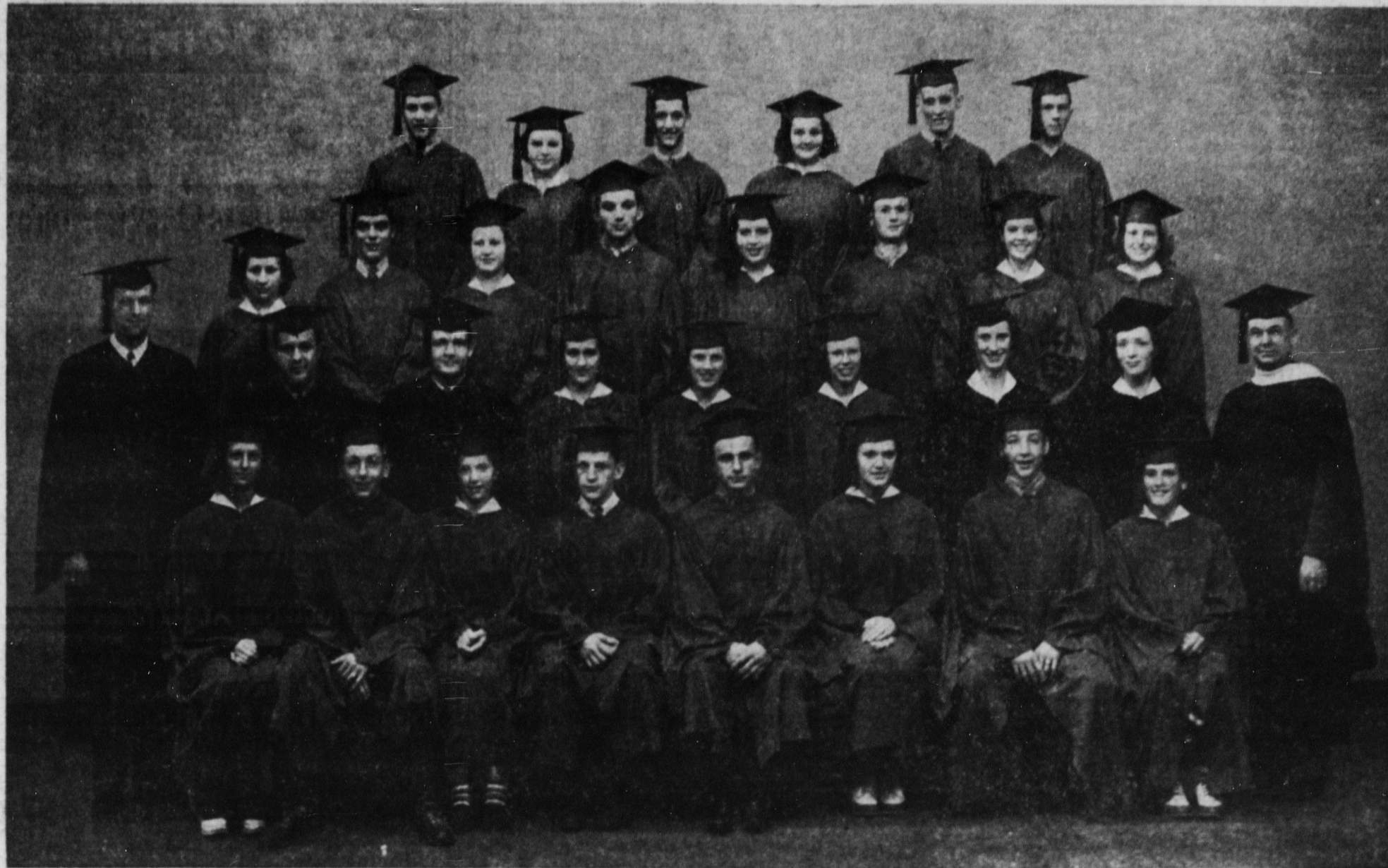
