HOUSEHOLD HINTS

Homemade Rubber Mat Try binding several canvas jar rubbers together with some string and using this as a mat for the cleaning powder box.

Carpeted Stairways Try using a whisk broom for cleaning the carpeted stairways. It gets into all the corners of both carpet and woodwork and prevents dust from accumulating.

Head Colds A bad head cold can often be relieved by placing a piece of camphor in an old saucer, setting it on fire, and after burning for a few minutes, blowing it out and inhaling the camphor fumes.

A Clean Chimney If a little salt-peter is sprinkled over the fire occasionally, it will keep the chimney free of soot.

To Brighten Furniture When the furniture is in need of brightening, first wash with a pure soap, using a soft cloth; then rinse and dry. Mix equal parts of linseed oil, turpentine, and vinegar.

Linoleum Care Paraffin oil rubbed into the linoleum will bring out the colors, make it wear twice as long, and impart a glossy surface.

Mending Kid Gloves Always be sure, when mending kid gloves, to use cotton thread. It hasn't the tendency to tear the leather when you are sewing, and makes the gloves wear better.

James Krape, who had been employed as janitor at the Bellefonte Hospital, had resigned to accept his former position as janitor in the Eastern Refractories Company office on High Street.

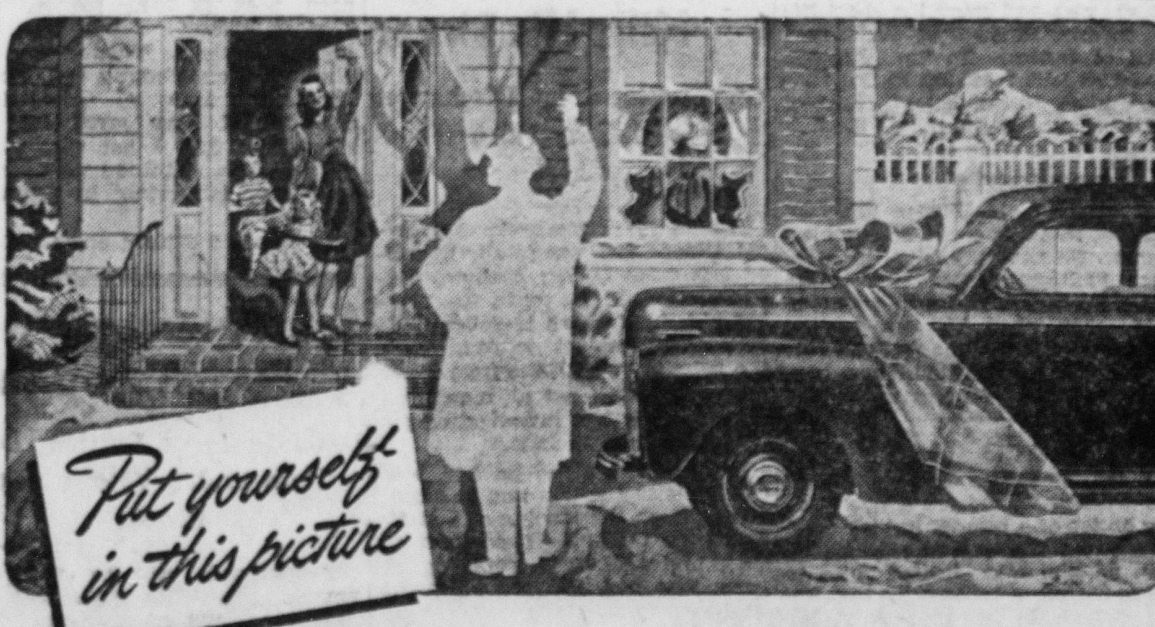
POULTRY POINTERS
