Anglers Jam Paradise at Eighth Annual Opening; 1,350 Fishermen Catch Total of 1,230 Trout; Day's Kill 567



Seeing is believing and this is what our photographer saw last Friday as Pennsylvania's famous Fishermen's Paradise, south of Bellefonte, opened for the 1941 season. Standing elbow to elbow, anglers good-naturedly spent most of their time untangling their lines and trying to cast their lures out into the water without committing mayhem upon neighboring enthusiasts. And in spite of these difficulties, to say nothing of chill winds and cold rain squalls, fish were caught. When the hectic day was over, records revealed that a total of 1230 trout had been hooked and landed, and of them, 567 were killed. It is a rather sad commentary upon the intelligence of trout, for not a blessed one of them was hooked on anything edible. The only lures allowed in the Paradise are artificial ones, and a survey of the things on which trout were caught ranged everywhere from wads of cotton to a fair imitation of a Pearly-Winged-Gadfly. Spawned in the Light of the Moon. Of course the entire mile-long Paradise was not jammed as heavily as indicated in the photos above, but a person had to step warily and swiftly anywhere on the lot to escape the whirling lines and flying hooks as some 1,350 fly casters tried to make a name for themselves. Of that total, 1,115 were fishermen; 136 were anglers dressed in gaudy-hued clothing which gave unappealing color to the scene, and 99 were youngsters who came to try their luck. It was a far cry from the paltry 361 anglers who turned out for the initial opening day in 1934. But the attendance wasn't quite up to last year's peak of 1,533. Par- (Continued on Page 4)
