(Continued from page one) present 100 candlepower ones. Lamps in all other residential areas will be provided with 250 candlepower bulbs instead of the present ones of 100 candlepower. The added cost to the borough for electric power will be about \$55 a month—as Ralph Lightner of the West Penn put it—about half the wage an extra borough employee would receive. And half the work of an extra man, he said, couldn't hold a candle to the vast improvement which will result in street lighting.
