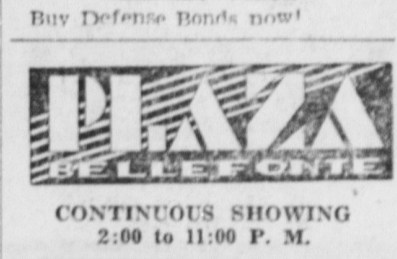
MANS AIR-WARNING OBSERVATION POST AT 91
