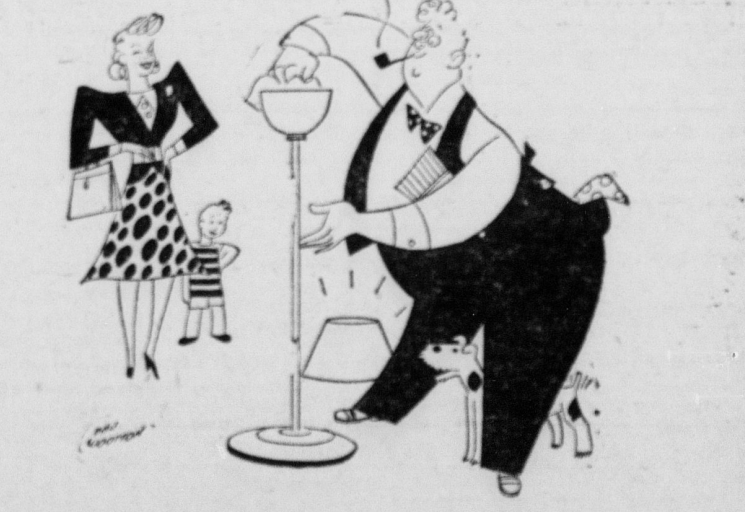
ANSWERS TO MILITARY I. Q.
