was received, it was decided to ask for other bids before taking any action.

The committee reported that repairs to sidewalks and curbs on Willowbank street are nearing completion and that the total cost of the work will be about \$1,600. The State Highway Department has completed a traffic count at the corner of Allegheny and Linn streets, but no report has been received in regard to the count. The figures are to be used as a guide in determining whether a set of traffic lights now on hand should be erected there instead of at the intersection of High and Water streets as originally planned.

The Highway Department inspected the bridge over Gamble mill race on West High street and has decided to install temporary supports until next spring when new steel beams will be placed under the structure.

It was reported that the Bellefonte Council of Civilian Defense has spent a total of \$902.40 of a fund of \$2,017.95 contributed for local defense needs to date. The air raid sirens soon will be operated from a central location in town and two of the sirens are to be relocated as follows: the one on the Ford garage, West High street, is to be moved along the railroad tracks to the Kofman building, and the one at the West Penn Power Company storeroom on West Linn street is to be located at the Thomas Coal Yard, further west on the same street. It is believed these changes will result in a better distribution of the warning signals.

A recent meeting of Councilmen with School Board members to discuss a proposed revision of borough property assessments resulted in no definite action since a State College tax expert reported that there is not sufficient time to follow out the plan completed in State College. The Borough solicitor is to be asked for advice in the matter.

The finance committee reported that the borough is operating well within the limits of the budget so far this year.

An application for a maintenance post in the borough was received from Melvin McMullen and was referred to Borough Manager Phillip Saylor. Because of the new 5 per cent wage tax scheduled to begin in January, Council decided to change the pay days of hourly employees to the 1st and 15th of each month. It was explained that such a move would facilitate the keeping of borough records.

The fire and police committee reported collection of \$56.60 in fines, and a list of Undine officers and drivers submitted by the committee was approved by Council.

Meter collections for the month period were \$401.30 and the police report was as follows: 50 cars tagged for parking violations, 4 arrests for drunk and disorderly conduct, and 11 persons lodged in lockup. All parking in West Pike street, from the Schaeffer Hardware store to the alley at the rear of the YMCA building was banned because parking in that section makes the road
