Words Often Misspelled

Valid, one l; pallid, two l's. Champagne (wine); campaign (a series of operations to bring about some result). Mistake, one s; misstate, two s's. Arrangement, gem; acknowledgment, gm.

Words Often Mispronounced

Cavalier. Pronounce kay-lee-er, first a as in at, i as in it, second a as in ah, principal accent on last syllable.
Divina (prima donna). Pronounce de-va, e as in me, a as in ask unstressed, accent first syllable.
