ANNOUNCEMENTS FOR AUDITOR. Mrs. Clyde Watson of Milesburg, Centre county, wishes to announce at this time her decision to run for County Auditor. As it is too late to have her name on the primary ballot, she kindly asks your support by writing, printing or pasting stickers with her name on the Democratic ballot at the primary election. At present she is chairman of the Medical Corps Casualty of the Centre County Civilian Defense Post at Milesburg; also a member of the OPA Price Panel, of which she has given time, energy and use of car absolutely free. She has not only given time and financial aid to the war, she has made a much greater sacrifice by giving her two sons to Uncle Sam. Sgt. Irvin Watson, of Camp Perry, Ohio, and A/S Kenneth S. Watson, of Marshall College, Huntington, W. Va., are both her sons. If elected she will be on her own merits and not by bought votes as her religious beliefs will not permit it. She kindly asks your support.

Another contested office on the Democratic ticket is for Commissioner, Charles F. Hipple, of Bellefonte, and Fred C. Mensch of Millheim, present incumbents, are seeking re-election on the strength of their record for the past three-and-a-half years. And when you look over their accomplishments in the way of tax reduction, debt reduction and reductions in the cost of county government, you have to admit they've turned in a mighty fine piece of work. If that means anything to the average voter, Hipple and Mensch should get a strong vote at the primaries.

Opposing them is Alfred L. Bowersox, of State College, who was the minority member of the former Board of Commissioners when Balser Weber and Paul N. Eckley were majority members. The G. O. P. has a long list of candidates for Commissioner. They are: John H. Henszey, State College contractor; Harry V. Keeler, former Sheriff and present County Commissioner; Balser Weber of Howard, former Commissioner; William H. Brouse, Bellefonte merchant and school director; N. Roy Stiver, Huston township lumberman, construction worker and former highway employee; Charles H. Watson, Snow Shoe coal operator; O. P. McCord, of Rush township, former game protector, and William H. Brown of Bellefonte, who at one time or another has held most of the County offices.

The only other office in which there is a Democratic contest is for Treasurer, and this writer, after viewing the situation carefully, confidently predicts that the Democratic nominee will be known as "Sam, the garageman". The candidates are Samuel H. Poorman, Bellefonte garageman, and Samuel A. Bierly, Rebersburg garageman.

The Republican party has several other interesting contests. Harold D. Cowher, county chairman, resigned that post to become a candidate for County Treasurer, while Lucille S. Ward of Bellefonte, county vice chairman, resigned that post to become a candidate for Register. The election may indicate whether the chairmanship and vice chairmanship may be considered as stepping-stones into County office.

Other candidates for Treasurer are Edward R. Miller, the present Sheriff; Fred V. Pletcher, of Howard; J. R. Williams, of Unionville, and W. Leslie Thomas, Bellefonte merchant and councilman.

Two Republican third-termers appear on the primary ballots. Up to this time several county office holders have been elected for third terms but not as a general practice. In September Bond C. White will seek nomination for his third term for Prothonotary and Leamer R. Woodruff will seek nomination for his third term as Recorder. White's opponents for the nomination are Merrill E. Pletcher, of Howard, present Jury Commissioner, and James L. Adams, of Phillipsburg, Woodruff is opposed at the primaries by James H. Schreck, Lemont paragon, and Jacob C. Fox, of Unionville.

Centre county has never elected a woman office holder, and for that reason politicians are watching Lucille Ward's campaign with interest. Other candidates for the office of Register are Harry R. Burd, of Haines township; Frank K. Stevenson, of Patton township; Clark N. Alkey, Bellefonte railroad man, and Charles B. Musser, of Bellefonte.

For County Auditor the present incumbents David A. Holter and Ralph R. Hartssock are being challenged by James R. Hughes, of Bellefonte, former Academy headmaster, and Howard M. Miles, of Union township, one-time County Commissioner.

Those are the primary contests in the county election. In those contests will be centered most of the interest of voters on September 14. Take your pick, but pick carefully.
