Fifty Years Ago

A special train was run from Penn State College on Monday evening for the jubilee singers. Over one hundred passengers came to town.

On Monday night a steam pipe burst in front of the Presbyterian church and did some damage to the interior furnishings.

Last Friday a gang of workmen began tearing away the ruins of the old Centre building. A new residence is erecting a new extension on Thomas street. It will be a handsome building.

Last week some night prowlers managed to get a lot of meat from Orrin Miller's smoke house and several articles were taken from other places.

On Monday, Saturday Joshua Folk, Policemen Garis and Montgomery, and W. H. Wine went to the premises of William Hannon, below the nail works, and after searching the premises they found a wash boiler buried near the shanty, containing most of the missing meat.

About 6:30 o'clock on Wednesday evening fire was discovered in one of the students' rooms in the preparatory department on the 5th floor of the Pennsylvania State College. The fire started behind a radiator and burned the floor so that the radiator fell through to the fourth floor.
