Local Paratrooper Flies To Alaska

A local Paratrooper, Pvt. Harry N. Barner, of Bellefonte, is flying with the 82d Airborne Division Battalion Combat Team to Alaska to participate in Exercise "Firestep", a territory-wide maneuver in April. The Battalion Combat Team is commanded by Lieutenant Colonel Ralph D. Burns, of Gulfport, Miss., and will be composed of the First Battalion, 505th Airborne Infantry Regiment, supported by Battery A, 466th Airborne Artillery Battalion, and one platoon of the 307th Airborne Engineers. The maneuver will test ground and air defenses in the Alaskan theater, with major activity centered in the Kodiak, Anchorage and Fairbanks area. It will be the first maneuver in Alaska involving all three Armed Services, and possible civil defense organizations. Canada will cooperate with the United States in the exercise by providing areas for staging 82d Airborne Division paratroopers prior to their drops in Alaska. Trooper Barner is the son of Mrs. Sarah Barner, of Bellefonte RD 3.
